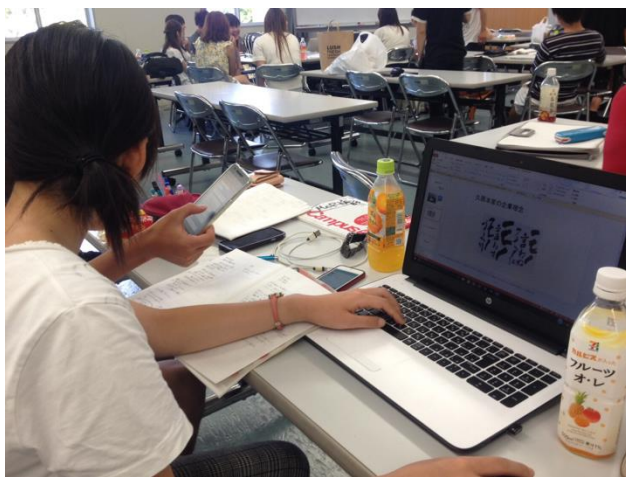


Life in Fukuoka

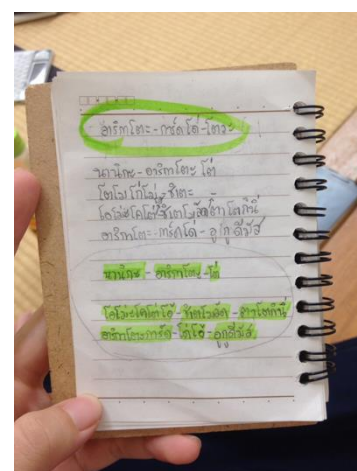
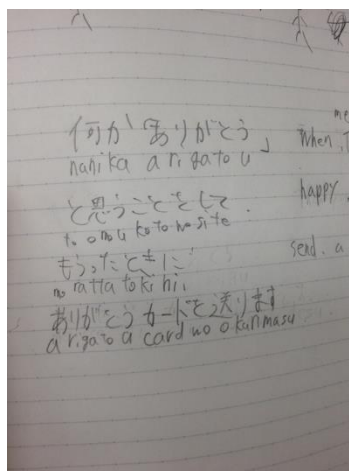
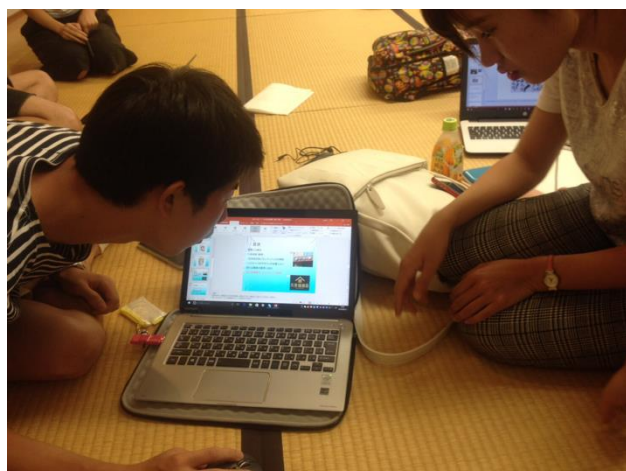
